SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying the \$15 entry fee to Clean Lakes Festival before 12:30 PM on August 27, 2011.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be verbally given at the skipper's meeting at 12:30 PM at Olin Park.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the Race Committee boat located at the Olin Park dock. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 1 hour after flag AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG

A competitors' meeting will be held at 12:30 PM at Olin Park. The warning signal for the race will be at 2:00 PM. There will be an all-fleet start.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be near the center of Lake Monona.

7 COURSE and MARKS

The course will be an Olympic course. All marks will be rounded to port.

8 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between the race committee boat and the corresponding mark. The Sound Signal Starting System in Appendix S of the racing rules will be used.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the race will be 1 ½ hour for the first boat to finish.

10 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the race committee at Olin Park within 30 minutes after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing. The 720 rule will be in effect.

11 SCORING

One race is scheduled. One race constitutes a series. Scoring will be done on using the Portsmouth rating. Top three finishers plus top female and top junior will be awarded trophies. Trophies will be presented on stage at Olin Park at about 5:45 PM.
